

Hurst Festival 100 Club

Terms and Conditions

The Promoter

The 100 Club is a Small Society Lottery (Registration LI/26/0817 granted by MSDC) promoted by Hurst Festival, hereinafter referred to as 'the Club'.

Objective

The aim of the Club is to raise funds to promote inclusivity by subsidising the cost of ticketed events and funding free-to-attend events. The funds raised will be divided between the prize money, and the Club's fundraising account on an approximate 30/70 basis.

Eligibility

The 100 Club is open to all supporters, volunteers, committee, staff and Trustees of Hurst Festival. All participants must be aged 16 or over, complying with the Gambling Act 2005 regulations for private lotteries.

Contractors, Trustees or committee members directly involved with the management of the 100 Club may not participate, unless authorised by the Trustees

Registration and Number Allocation

Participants must apply using the appropriate fields on the Hurst Festival website to create an account. If an account already exists, the number(s) purchased will be added to that account. Upon joining the chosen, unique number (or numbers) between 1 and 100 will be allocated to that individual.

There is no limit to how many numbers a member can purchase, subject to availability.

Payment and Subscriptions

The cost of each number is £5 per month.

Payments must be made in advance and at least 14 days before the next draw if that number is to be included. Method of payment is by credit/debit card via the website,

A member's number will only be entered into the draw if their subscription is fully paid and up to date at the time of the draw.

If a payment fails the member will be contacted by a 100 Club administrator and asked if they would like to update their payment details, or leave the Club. If the latter is the case, the number can then be reallocated.

The Draw

The draw will take place on, or around, the 20th of each month at a village location that will be advertised on the Hurst Festival website.

The draw will be made from a secure container, by an independent member of the public and overseen by at least 2 Hurst Festival officials/representatives. A Festival Trustee holds the Gambling Licence and is not permitted to own a number in the draw

Prize Structure

The monthly prize is £100, paid by bank transfer, no prizes will be paid in cash. If membership falls to below operating levels, the 100 Club draw will have to be suspended until the membership has increased sufficiently. If this is the case all members will be contacted and subscriptions temporarily suspended.

Winning and Notification

Winners will be notified personally, by email or telephone shortly after the draw is held.

Winning numbers will be published on the Hurst Festival website and social media pages. First names will also be published unless the participant has requested anonymity when joining by emailing the 100 Club administrator.

Prize money will be distributed via bank transfer within 7 days of the draw provided the winner has been contactable.

If a winner cannot be contacted after 3 calendar months following a draw the prize money will be donated back into Hurst Festival's 100 Club fundraising account.

Security

Upon joining each member will be asked to set up a secure word or phrase and asked to challenge the Festival representative when he/she calls to congratulate the winner and ask for bank details in order to transfer the prize money. The 100 Club administrator will quote the secure word or phrase to reassure the member of the legitimacy of the request.

Cancellation

Members may withdraw from the 100 Club at any time by logging into their account and cancelling their subscription.

Disputes

In the event of any dispute regarding the rules, draws, or results, the decision of the Hurst Festival Trustees will be final.

The Hurst Festival Trustees reserve the right to modify or cancel the 100 Club if circumstances make this necessary
